Rosso Corsa is hugely aromatic, wild and of singular personality. The wine is an expert blend of two distinctive clones, hand harvested on a single day. Whole-cluster inclusion and native yeast fermentation add a Burgundian complexity and silky texture. This special vintage spent 19 months in French oak barrels and was bottled without fining or filtration.
